P3 CCA

CCAs are essential and integral part of education for our students. Besides allowing students to discover their interests and talents, they provide platforms for students to develop their character, learn values, social emotional competencies and other relevant skills to prepare them for future challenges. Thus, the P3 students are encouraged to participate in one CCA.

The P3 students will start their first CCA session in Term 1 Week 4 (26 January to 28 January 2023). Students in the CCAs are expected to attend CCA regularly. CCA record will only be endorsed by the CCA Teachers if he/ she satisfies the 80% attendance criterion. Students are also strongly encouraged to stay committed to their chosen CCA throughout the year. Students who are not able to attend any session are to inform the CCA Teachers with a letter of excuse or a medical certificate.

The CCA Teachers will send out CCA information to the parents by the end of Term 1 Week 2.
