Primary 1 Term 4 Level Matters

Welcome back! We hope your child had a restful week and is ready for another exciting term. Here is an update of the activities happening in Term 4.

Programme for Active Learning (PAL)

Our students will delve into the realm of Performing Arts once again, this time focusing on Drama. The objective of this module is to provide students with an authentic context to learn, experience and apply the SE competencies: self-awareness, self-management, social awareness, relationship management and responsible decision-making. It is our aspiration that students will adeptly apply these SE competencies in their daily lives, thereby enriching their overall personal growth and development.

Physical Education, Art, and Music (PAM)

Through Physical Education, students will be engaging in a variety of activities aimed at promoting physical skills and healthy habits. In gymnastics, students will learn to perform a sequence involving two different movements with smooth transitions, enhancing their coordination and control. Students will continue to develop key movement patterns through games and sports activities. Additionally, students will explore important concepts related to physical health and safety. They will gain an understanding of the components of a balanced diet, the importance of eating fruits and vegetables, and how to identify healthier drink and snack options, including the recommended daily intake. These lessons aim to support students' physical development while also encouraging lifelong healthy habits. We look forward to a fun and active term ahead!

For Art, students will be introduced to drawing as a visual language and a means of personal expression. The lessons aim to nurture their natural inclination to draw while fostering freedom, confidence, and joy in visual expression.

The Music curriculum will introduce students to simple rhythms, encouraging them to create their own rhythmic ostinato using body percussion alongside a song. They will also explore the concept of musical phrases and demonstrate comprehension by adapting their actions or movements in response to different aspects of a song.

There will be an online PTM for selected parents on 24 September 2025 (Wednesday). Only invited parents are asked to attend so that we can better address specific needs and concerns of these students. Please note that school will continue as per usual on that day for P1-5 students.
