Dear Parents/Guardians,

Primary 2 Term 4 Level Matters

Welcome back! We hope the children had a good break during the September holidays. We have now come to the final term of the year. Here is an update of the activities in Term 4.

Physical Education, Art and Music (PAM)

For Physical Education, students will continue with Gymnastics lessons, where they will apply basic movement skills to create and perform a simple gymnastics sequence. They will also continue the Games and Sports module, learning skills such as striking objects with an implement and dribbling with both hands and an implement.

For Art, lessons will focus on nurturing students' innate drawing abilities and fostering creative exploration through guided, playful activities. Students will broaden their visual vocabulary and build greater confidence in expressing ideas and emotions through drawing.

For Music, students will learn to compose melodic ostinatos in the pentatonic scale using tone chimes to accompany a song. They will also explore patterns in music and develop the ability to listen to and identify simple pieces in binary (AB) and ternary (ABA) form. In addition, students will sing a canon with actions as a class and perform a percussion ensemble piece.

HI-LITE Programme: Children's Museum

Students will be visiting the Children's Museum for their learning journey. More details will be shared by their form teachers via Parents Gateway closer to the date.

Parent-Teacher Meeting (PTM)

A PTM for selected parents will be held on 24 September 2025 (Wednesday). Only the invited parents are requested to attend, allowing us to better address the specific needs of these students. It will be a normal school day for Primary 1–5 students, following the usual curriculum hours.
