Programme for Active Learning (PAL)

Programme for Active Learning (PAL) was introduced by the Ministry of Education (MOE) in 2011 and will be conducted for all Primary 1 and Primary 2 students. PAL aims to facilitate the well-rounded development of students in the five learning domains (cognitive, moral, social, aesthetics and physical) and help students to develop social and emotional competencies. The modules are experiential in nature and incorporate learning in a creative, fun, and enjoyable way. The following modules will be offered to Primary 2 students during curriculum time:

Physical Education, Art and Music (PAM)

The Primary 2 students will continue their Physical Education (PE) programme from last year, focusing on Fundamental Movement Skills (FMS). In Term 1, they will engage in Gymnastics and the Games and Sports modules. In Gymnastics, students will acquire skills in both locomotor and non-locomotor movements. During Games and Sports, they will participate in enjoyable activities and games, enhancing skills such as dribbling with hands, throwing and catching.

The Art Education programme in Primary 2 will centre on two artworks: "The Snail" by Henri Matisse and "Rawa-Rawa" by Sarkasi Said. By delving into the narratives behind these artworks and comparing the use of lines, shapes, and colors to depict intriguing aspects of animals, students will gain insights into different artistic techniques and styles. This exposure will inspire them in creating their own paper animal collages.

In the realm of Music, students will explore performing a steady beat on both body percussion and percussion instruments while singing. They will also delve into solfege hand signs, adapt lyrics to a short song, and appreciate music from Chinese culture, aligning with the Chinese New Year celebrations.

Silent Reading

Every morning, the students will report either to the school hall or directly to their respective class and read their storybooks silently. We strongly encourage our students to bring English or Mother Tongue storybooks from Monday to Friday.

Student Diary

The student diary will be used as a means of communication between teachers and parents. Students should use the diary to take note of their daily homework and reminders from their teachers. We hope that you will check your child's student diary regularly.
