The assessment structure for the examinable subjects (English Language, Mother Tongue Language, Mathematics and Science) is as follows:

### Non-weighted Assessments

There are no weighted assessments in Term 1. The subject teachers will be carrying out formative assessments to monitor students' learning. There will be no make-up for students who are absent on the day of assessment.

### Weighted Assessments

There will be weighted assessments in Terms 2 to 4. Refer to Annex A for the weighted assessments schedule for Terms 2 and 3. Your child's subject teachers will inform the class of the actual date of the weighted assessment two weeks before the assessment. Please note that the Term 4 assessment schedule will be shared with you later.

There is no make-up available for students who are absent on the day of assessment. If your child is absent for the assessment, his/her subject teacher will pass the assessment paper to him/her for practice. It will not be counted as a weighted assessment. Marks will be pro-rated for students who submit their medical certificate (MC). A mark of zero will be given for students who are absent without a reason deemed valid by the school.
